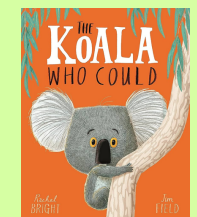
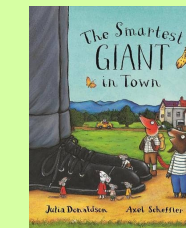
## Vocabulary

### History

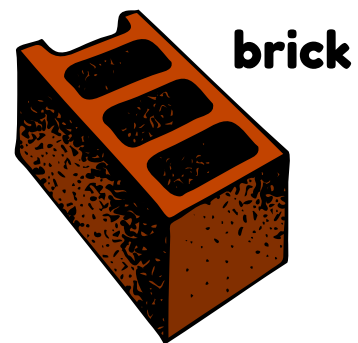
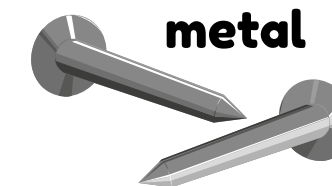
- Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole, Edith Cavell were nurses who helped people.

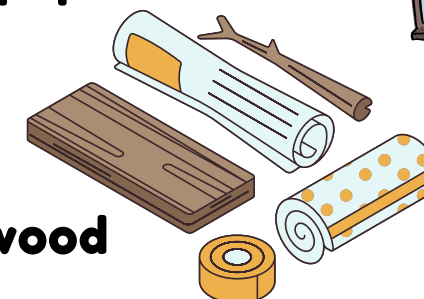

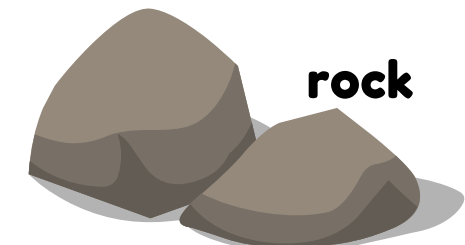
