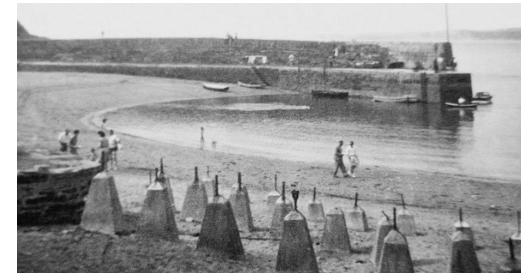




Year 6 Homework Grid

Animals were used a lot throughout the war, from posting pigeons to horses. Research an amazing animal story to tell your class.

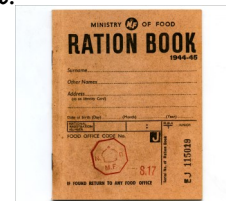


Ask a family member about your family history.
